When might you use a sling?


Slings are indispensable aids in various scenarios to assist patients with limited mobility. Everyday situations where slings come into play include:

- Patient transfers: Moving patients from one place to another, such as from a bed to a chair or vice versa.
- Bathing and toileting: Ensuring safety and dignity during hygiene-related activities.
- **Repositioning:** Adjusting a patient's position in bed or chair to prevent pressure sores and improve comfort.
- Mobility support: Aiding patients during ambulation or walking exercises.
- Lifting from the floor: Helping patients after a fall.

Different types of slings

Slings are available in various designs to cater to specific needs and transfer requirements. Some offer more support, while others provide greater access.

The primary types of sling are:



In-Situ or Hammock Sling

Designed for extended use, providing excellent comfort for patients requiring longer periods in the sling. It offers complete support and pressure distribution, minimising the risk of pressure sores.

Deluxe Hammock Sling

Designed to be easier to remove once the patient is seated. The split leg design offers increased patient dignity whilst being transferred.


Universal Sling

Versatile and suitable for many patient transfer tasks. A good all-rounder, they can be used for general transfers and repositioning. Supports the whole body, including the shoulders.

Toileting or Dual Access Sling

Designed to be used from a sitting position to facilitate toileting and bathing activities for patients with limited mobility. It features an open-back design, allowing easy access for personal care. It can be used with a patient lifting hoist or a stand aid.



Our Slings

They are colour-coded to make positioning and connection to a hoist as simple as possible.

- Unique colour-coded loops on straps help ensure the sling is correctly positioned and connected to the hoist. Loop colours identified during the assessment can be recorded in the client's care plan for reference.
- **Colour-coded edging** provides a visual aid to help identify the sling size.
- 3 Label provides important sling information.
- **Guide handles** to facilitate correct handling during client transfers.
- Leg sections include padding slip/fit material to the outside of the leg sections, eliminating unnecessary bulk in areas that are not functional.
- 6 Centre markers assist the caregiver in correctly positioning the sling, especially from a lying position or when introducing the sling with a slide sheet.

- · Spacer fabric for increased comfort
- Should be applied to a client in the supine position
- Designed without handles to minimise pressure points
- Option available with head support
- Not suitable for toileting as the sling has no aperture

Prism Deluxe Support Sling

A supportive and comfortable sling designed to accommodate most clients.

- Quilted leg sections and no binding on the outer leg section for extra comfort (excluding spacer fabric)
- · Can be used in divided leg or crossover position
- · Shaped to prevent creases under the leg section
- Option available with head support
- Available in polyester/slip-fit, mesh, slip-fit and spacer fabrics

The universal is the most commonly supplied sling for general transfer purposes.

Moving and handling equipment and repositioning aids are essential tools in healthcare settings to ensure the safety and comfort of patients and caregivers during various tasks.

Here's when they are commonly used:

- 1. Patient mobility: Moving and handling equipment is used when patients have limited mobility or cannot move independently. This includes transferring patients from beds to chairs, wheelchairs or commodes.
- 2. Preventing injuries: Repositioning aids and equipment prevents injuries to patients and healthcare workers. They reduce the risk of strains, sprains, and musculoskeletal injuries during manual lifting and repositioning.
- 3. Bedbound patients: When caring for patients confined to bed, moving and handling equipment such as hoists, slings and slide sheets are used to reposition patients, change bedding, and maintain hygiene without causing discomfort or harm.
- 4. Patient dignity: These solutions help maintain patient dignity by ensuring smooth and respectful transfers and movements. Patients often feel more at ease and secure when appropriate equipment is used.

Different types of manual handling and repositioning solutions

- Bed management systems Cost-effective onthe-bed solutions for those requiring frequent repositioning and turning. These systems consist of two sheets: an undersheet and a top sheet that is moved to reposition the client.
- Multigloves and handling belts Useful aids that allow carers to safely perform everyday moving and handling tasks, such as repositioning, moving and fitting slings, without injury or friction to the skin.
- **Transfer boards** Low-friction boards specifically designed to assist patients when transferring from one surface to another.
- **Emergency manual transfer systems** Essential moving and handling equipment for use in an emergency when it is vital to transfer patients to a safe area.
